FINAL DECREE

And now, this 4 day of June, A. D. 1917, the within certificate of incorporation having been presented, and it appearing that the order of court heretofore made has been complied with, and it further appearing that the College and University Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has caused to be endorsed on said application or certificate of incorporation its findings and its approval of the same, with a certain limitation, together with a recommendation to the Court of Common Pleas for the County of Lackawanna, before whom the same was originally presented, that the same be granted with said limitation, said endorsement, and approval being as follows:

"Harrisburg, Pa., May 25, 1917.

The application or certificate of Marywood College at Scranton, Pa., having been duly considered and the Council being of the opinion that the educational needs of the particular locality in which the Institution is situated and of the Commonwealth at large are likely to be met by the granting of the application, this Council unanimously finds that said Institution should be granted the power to grant the degrees of Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Science in Household Economics, and unanimously approves the application of said Institution with this limitation, and unanimously recommends to the Court of Common Pleas No. 4, for the County of Lackawanna that a final decree be made granting the petition of the said Institution, provided that

the said Institution file a stipulation that it will grant no degrees except those above stated, without further application to this Council;"

and it further appearing that said Marywood College has filed in this Court a stipulation that it will grant no degrees except the degrees of Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Science in Household Economics, without further application to the College and University Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and after giving consideration to the findings of said Council and being satisfied with the propriety of the application in view of all the facts, the said certificate of incorporation, with said limitation, is hereby approved, and it is ordered and decreed that upon the recording of said certificate of incorporation with the recommendation of said Council and a copy of said order of Court and this decree in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Lackawanna County, the subscribers thereto and their associates and successors shall be a corporation for the purpose and upon the terms therein set forth, with the limitation contained in the said endorsement and approval of the College and University Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and thenceforth the persons named therein and subscribing the same, and their associates and successors shall be a corporation by the name of Marywood College.
