June 25, 2026

To acknowledge receipt of the self-study report. To reaffirm accreditation. To note the on-site evaluation visit by Commission representatives to the main campus at 2300 Adams Avenue, Scranton, PA 18509 on March 22-25, 2026. To note the following additional location was visited: 2755 Station Avenue, Center Valley, PA 18034. To request a supplemental information report, due August 14, 2028, providing further evidence of organized and systematic assessments evaluating the extent of student achievement of institutional and degree/program goals (Standard V) (Fourteenth Edition and Evidence Expectations by Standard Guidelines). The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2033-2034.

January 3, 2023

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. To include the written arrangement with Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport to serve as a third-party provider offering 67% of the of the Master of Business Administration program within the institution's scope of accreditation. To note that the Commission's approval does not include eligibility for Title IV, HEA programs. To require written evidence of approvals from all necessary licensing, regulatory, or other legal entities as necessary. To note the Commission may rescind this action if the requested substantive change is not implemented within one calendar year from the date of this action. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2025-2026.

June 22, 2022

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. To note the institution's decision to close the additional location at 200 Prospect Street, East Stroudsburg, PA 18301-2999 that has ceased operations. To remove the additional location from the institution's scope of accreditation. To note that the Commission reserves the right to rescind this action if any developments reveal additional information that might have affected the Commission's decision. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2025-2026.

June 23, 2021

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. To note the institution's decision to close the additional location at 400 East Second Street, Bloomsburg, PA 17815. To require immediate notification when instruction ceases at the additional location. To note the Commission may rescind this

action if any developments reveal additional information that might have affected the Commission's decision and/or the requested substantive change is not implemented within one calendar year from the date of this action. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2025-2026.

April 29, 2021

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. To include the written arrangement with Zijing Education, Room 501-1, 5th Floor, Block 7, Yard 1, Zhongguancun East Road, Haidian District, Beijing, China to serve as a third-party provider of the Master of Business Administration within the institution's scope of accreditation. To note that the Commission reserves the right to rescind approval of this substantive change if any developments reveal additional information that might have affected the Commission's decision and/or the requested substantive change is not implemented within one calendar year from the date of this action. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2025-2026.

March 15, 2018

To accept the monitoring report and note that a small team visit will not be conducted at this time. The next evaluation is scheduled for 2025-2026.

March 2, 2017

To reaffirm accreditation and to request a monitoring report, due December 1, 2017, documenting further evidence of (1) development and implementation of a comprehensive institutional strategic plan that links long-range planning to decision-making and budgeting processes (Standard 2); (2) development and implementation of an operating and capital budget process □ including multi-year budget projections □ that is aligned with the institution's mission, goals, and strategic plan (Standard 3); (3) further implementation of a comprehensive, organized, and sustained process for the assessment of institutional effectiveness with evidence that assessment information is used in budgeting, planning, and allocating resources (Standard 7); and (4) development and implementation of a comprehensive multi-year enrollment management model that informs budgeting and planning (Standard 8). A small team visit may follow submission of the report. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2025-2026.

February 23, 2016

To grant the institution a six-month extension on the self-study. The evaluation team visit will now occur during the fall semester 2016.

January 4, 2016

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request. To note the institution's decision to close its additional location at Alvernia College - School of Social Work, 400 Saint Bernardine Street, Reading, PA 19607. The

Commission requires notification within thirty days of the closure of this additional location. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2015-2016.

September 3, 2013

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request and to include the additional location at East Stroudsburg University, 200 Prospect Street, East Stroudsburg, PA 18301 within the scope of the institution's accreditation. The Commission requires written notification within thirty days of the commencement of operations at this additional location. In the event that operations at the additional location do not commence within one calendar year from the approval of this action, approval will lapse. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2015-2016.

June 27, 2013

To accept the supplemental information report addressing the Fall 2012 National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. (NLNAC) action. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2015-2016.

April 15, 2013

To request a supplemental information report, due May 13, 2013, addressing the Fall 2012 National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc. (NLNAC) accreditation decision. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2015-2016.

November 17, 2011

To accept the Periodic Review Report and to reaffirm accreditation. The next evaluation visit is scheduled for 2015-2016.

August 30, 2011

To acknowledge receipt of the substantive change request, to note the institution's decision to close the additional location at Keystone College, One College Green, La Plume, PA 18440 and to remove the location from the scope of the institution's accreditation. To note that the Periodic Review Report due June 1, 2011, has been received and will be acted upon at the Commission's November meeting.
